FURAVERI SOUTH (HOUSE REEF)* 1A**


Our house reef right in front the arrival jetty is our warm-up dive. The reef on the eastern side has a unique formation of hard corals and a sandy bed. We start this dive from the beach and it will take around 5 minutes to get to the reef. The shallow top reef is very interesting and lots of schooling of fish like, jack fish, batfish, groupers and fusiliers are inhabitants of this colorful reef.

Location: 5 minutes (swimming distance) **Highlights**: schools of fish and hard corals Marine life: fusiliers, oriental sweetlips

Reef: house reef.

Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 20 meters.

Experience: Suitable for beginners.





















FURAVERI WEST (HOUSE REEF) ***1B

Close to the water villas on the North-West side of the island, the top reef starts at 3 meters depth and steeply falls down to 25 meters. On the corner formation of this reef is like little wall with overhangs. When the current flow is strong from the west, you will experience lots of surprises on this reef.

Location: 5 minutes by boat

Highlights: rich fish life and hard corals

Marine life: fusiliers, oriental sweetlips, barracudas, glassfish, spine bones, turtles,

moray eels, napoleons, blue striped snappers

Reef: long-stretched

Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 25 meters

Experience: For beginners



















SOLA CORNER * 2**

Sola corner is an outer reef with a shallow plateau surrounded by a quite steep slope reef. The plateau is covered with hard corals and hosts a cleaning station during the outgoing currents of the northeast monsoon. The wall surrounding the plateau presents many corals and algae, which host many species such as leaf fish, ghost pipefish, lobsters, turtles and moray eels. If manta rays are present near the surface, it is recommended to enter nearby. Divers can stay close to the cleaning station to observe the rays.












LABYRINTH *** 3



Medium-sized thila, which was formed centuries ago. Big rocks covered with soft corals and tunnels around the reef is covered by lots of colorful corals. The thila is characterized by its enormous fish and coral. The abundant presence of large numbers of batfish accompany each dive on this reef. Puffer fish, fusiliers, glassfish, perch, eagle rays, morays and imperator fish round the over hangs and canyon makes the overall experience of this reef outstanding.

Location: 35 minutes by boat.

High lights: Abundant fish life and hard corals Marine life: sharks, tuna, oriental sweetlips

Reef: A thila with an exciting canyon and overhangs.

Diving Depth: Min. 12 meters – Max. 30 meters. **Experience**: Suitable for experienced divers



















KUROSHI GIRI CANYON * 4**

Kuroshi Giri Canyon is a great dive location for all experience levels. You can dive along the canyon at 13 -20 meters depth. Many nice overhangs with lots of beautiful corals on the reef makes this place very promising for the divers. Fish life is abundant on most of the parts of the reef. Inside the caves we can often find nurse sharks and gaunt eels.



This dive site is a fantastic reef to see the different coral and fish lives. On the south side the reef has a very gentle slope with beautiful hard corals. Manta rays come by this dive site to get cleaned. Small reef inhabitants are very common on the whole wall and you can discover extremely beautiful tiny creatures. Look for stonefish, scorpion fish and of course all the small crabs which are hiding inside the table corals. Nudibranchs, snails and many different shrimps can be discovered along the whole dive.



RAINBOW CAVES * 6**


The southwestern corner of our great manta point is one of the nicest dive site to have easy-going dive with lots of exciting caves. Start at 5 meters on the top reef and find plenty of big overhangs full with sea fans, gorgonians and black corals dominate the reef below 15 meters. Fish life is above average, moray eels and crustaceans can be found along the reef as well as white tip reef sharks, stingrays, eagle rays, napoleon and big schools of banner fish, snappers, trevellies and sharks.

Location: 20 minutes by boat.

Highlights: Abundant fish life and soft and hard corals Marine life: rays, tuna, napoleon, oriental sweetlips **Reef**: The reef opens to the ocean on the south west side

Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 30 meters

Experience: For beginners and experienced divers

















KUKULHUDHOO*** 7

A very long wall with lots of sea fans, gorgonians, and big overhangs. Take a torch so you are able to spot all the lobsters hiding in the deeper caves. Big schools of fusiliers, hump head snappers and turtles are giving this wall a nice touch. As it is a channel entry dive, larger fish can frequently be seen. Fish life is very good on the every part of the reef, napoleons, tuna, eagle rays and lots of sweetlips are schooling up at different parts of the reef.



ORANGE CLIFF * 8**

The reef top is 5 to 8 m depth and has many big coral blocks with fascinating fish life. The northeastern corner slopes down to terraces deeper than 30 m and will impress you with nice overhangs. Big tunas, jack fish, fusiliers, red tooth trigger fish and snappers, but also sharks and eagle rays can often be seen. Behind the corner there is a steep slope with small caves and overhangs in depths between 12 and 20 m. There are turtles, stingrays, moray eels, lobsters and many small creatures like nudibranches and crabs.




MAAFARU THILA *10**

Very nice coral formations, sea fans, gorgonians, soft coral trees, table corals and big black coral bushes are found all along the reef. Long, big overhangs give good shelter if there is a current. On this dive spot you have everything. Lots of small inhabitants, schools of snappers, fusiliers, groups of sweet lips, yellow trumpet fish and, if lucky, you can also find some white tip reef sharks.

Location: 10 minutes by boat

Highlights: Abundant fish life and soft and hard corals Marine life: Sharks, ray, napoleon, oriental sweetlips **Reef**: A thila away from the main reef, inside of the atoll

Diving Depth: Min. 12 meters – Max. 30 meters



















MAAFARU CAVES *** 9

The north-eastern corner of Maafaru starts at 5 meters on the top reef and steep wall with plenty of big overhangs full with sea fans, gorgonians and black corals. The north side is a slope. All kinds of reef fish, moray eels and crustaceans can be found along the reef as well as white tip reef sharks, stingrays, eagle rays, napoleon and big schools of bannerfish, snappers, trevallies and sharks.

Location: 20 minutes by boat.



AARAH BODUTHILA * 11**


This thila is about 20 meters away from the main reef and can be reached by crossing over from the main reef. The top of this thila starts at 12 meters and drops down to 30 meters on the side. Barracudas and eagle rays are regularly seen on the deeper end of the thila. The big schools of oriental sweetlips is always a motive for photographers.

High lights: Abundant fish life, soft and hard corals Marine life: Sharks, ray, tuna, napoleon, sweetlips

Reef: A big thila detached from the main reef, inside of the atoll

Diving Depth: Min. 12 meters – Max. 30 meters **Experience**: For the more experienced diver

















AARAH KUDA THILA *** 12

This spectacular site has many different features. The top reef of the thila is around 10 meters deep while the deepest part goes down to around 30 meters. On the north end there is an outcrop filled with an abundant fish life. Large groups of blue striped snappersand fusiliers can be found here. On the east side often barracudas, napoleon wrasses and sharks are seen here. The reef is also well known for its excellent coral growth.












NAGILI THILA *13**



The three thilas which are located just beside the meedupparu house reef is beautiful place to experience soft and hard corals. Top reef is covered with big table corals, hard corals. Soft corals are more on the side of the two thila. A lots of other small fishes can be seen on the top reef. Overhangs are small but it's on the different depth and covered with soft corals.

Marine life: fusiliers, oriental sweetlips, barracudas, glassfish, spine bones, turtles,

moray eels, napoleons, blue striped snappers **Reef:** two small thilas along with a house reef Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 25 meters










KUDATHULHADHU NORTH * 14**



The north-west corner of this beautiful reef is a bit deferent formation of the corals than the south corner. 6 m on the top reef is covered by lots of hard corals, and more soft corals and gorgonians are filing the rest of the reef. This is one to the reef where you can find blue corals inside the caves and side of the reef. Fish life is very similar as south corner, expect more pelagic fish than south. Napoleons, grouper, morays, sweet-lips are common and often nurse sharks.

Location: 35 minutes boat ride

High lights: Nice overhangs, covered in soft corals, abundance of fish life

Marine life: Tuna, turtle, schools of snapper and fusilier

Reef: North side of a long reef

Diving Depth: Min. 10 meters – Max. 30 meters





















KUDATHULHADHU SOUTH *15**



This long reef hidden behind the outer reef make very protective environment from the ocean current flow. The south corner of this reef starts at 6m and falls down to 30m on the side with lots of overhangs and beautiful corals. This is one of the reefs where you can find blue corals inside the caves and on the slope. Abundant fish life is spread all over the corner, napoleons, groupers, morays, sweetlips are common species you will meet at this reef.

Location: 35 minutes boat ride **High lights**: Nice small overhangs

Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, schools of snapper and fusilier

Reef: Reef of kudhathulhadhu

Diving Depth: Min. 10 meters – Max. 30 meters **Experience**: For the more experienced diver




















MAAMUNA GAA FARU * 17**



Long reef with overhangs from 10 m depth downwards. You can see gorgeous yellow and light blue soft corals and gorgonians. Often you will meet eagle rays, napoleons and nurse sharks while you drift along the reef. Some of the overhangs are home for oriental sweetlips, perches, fusiliers, anemone fish and moray eels.

Location: 30 minutes boat ride

High lights: Nice overhangs with beautiful soft corals

Marine life: Tuna, trevally, schools of snappers and fusiliers

Reef: Small thila with overhangs

Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 30 meters

Experience: Suitable for beginners to experienced divers




















KUDATHULHADHU THILA * 16**



This thila has beautiful overhangs, amazing gorgonians with yellow soft corals as well as a range of hard corals. When the current flow is strong often the big pelagics like barracudas and jackfish come to action and you can see them hunting. Plenty of glassfish, napoleons, groupers, moray eels and sweetlips are found around the reef. Often turtles and occasionally eagle rays are also spotted.

Location: 15 minutes boat ride

Highlights: Nice overhangs with beautiful soft corals

Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, schools of snappers and fusiliers

Reef: Small thila with overhangs

Diving Depth: Min. 10 meters – Max. 30 meters **Experience**: For the more experienced diver



















MAAMUNA GAA KANDU * 18**



The northwestern corner of Maafaru starts 6 meters on the top reef and slopes down to 30 meters on the ocean side. The hard coral growth on the top reef and gorgonians on the slopes make this reef home for lots of different pelagic and reef fish. Beautiful overhangs at the depth of 15 to 20 meters on this reef makes the perfect place for beginners and experienced divers. Often you can spot morays, rays, different colorful fusiliers, nudibranches, snappers and turtles.

Location: 30 minutes boat ride

Highlights: nice overhangs with beautiful soft corals

Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, schools of snappers and fusiliers

Reef: Small thila with overhangs

Diving Depth: Min. 6 meters – Max. 30 meters




















FENFUSHI GIRI *** 19



A Giri on the top reef starts at around 3 meters and slopes down to 30+ meters. Beautiful overhangs can be admired from 14 m to 28 m. Rich coral growth on the top reef and colorful soft corals on the side and inside the overhang makes this reef magical for divers who love to take pictures. Large tunas, red-tooth-press triggerfish, moray eels, anemone fish, snappers, napoleons, turtles, groupers and mackerels are native of this reef.

Location: 20 minutes boat ride

Highlights: nice overhangs with beautiful soft corals

Marine life: Tuna, turtle, and fusiliers

Reef: Small thila with overhangs

Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 30 meters





















SOUTH WEST CORNER * 20**



The south east corner of Maamuna Gau has many caves and overhangs near the corner between 5 to 20 meters depth. The channel wall is steep – at one point it is quite deep, descending down to 40 meters. Turtles frequent the reef, as well as surgeon fish and black snappers. You can also expect to see lots of pelagic fish at the corner when current flow is stronger. At this reef you can find reef sharks, rays, napoleons and it is likely to spot a sleeping leopard shark in the sand.

Location: 40 minutes boat ride

Highlights: nice overhangs with beautiful soft corals. Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, schools of fish, sharks.

Reef: Long reef with overhangs

Diving Depth: Min. 3 meters – Max. 30 meters

Experience: Suitable for beginners to experienced divers





















MAAMUNA GAA GIRI *** 21



This beautiful Giri in-between two reefs on the eastern side of the atoll is filled with in with perches, glassfish, eagle-rays, moray eels, turtles, napoleons, lionfish, overhangs, hard and soft corals.

Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, schools of snapper and fusilier

Diving Depth: Min. 10 meters – Max. 30 meters




















VILIGILI THILA *** 22



A small thila with overhangs full of picturesque hard and soft corals. Often you will encounter glassfish, eagle rays, rainbow runners, turtles, moray eels and anemone fish.

Location: 20 minutes boat ride

Highlights: nice overhangs with beautiful soft corals

Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, schools of snapper and fusilier

Reef: Small thila with overhangs

Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 30 meters



















VAADHOO THILA * 23**



This medium-sized thila located a few hundred meters east of Dheburidheytherey Vaadhoo Island is surrounded by many coral blocks. On the western side, there are many overhangs starting at 15m. The marine fauna is very rich with species such as snappers, tunas and fusiliers. When the current is strong, it is recommended to perform the water entry upstream in the current, without air in the BCD and staying minimal time at the surface. A prior current check will be needed to determine the position for the boat placement.

Distance:30 minutes by boat

Marine life: Anthias, jack fish and full of triggerfish Highlights: Very colorful coral, lots of anemone fish.

Reef: A big thila arranged like STONEHENGE

Depth: 5 - 45 m

Difficulty: Easy - Difficult (depending on condition)



















BERIYAN BODU THILA *24**



Consists of 2 thilas. The larger (BODU) starts only 4m below the surface. It features small caves and a large overhang. From this overhang one dips to the smaller (KUDA) thila (top at 12 - 17 m) full of soft corals, black corals, green mug corals, gorgonians and overhangs. The thila falls down to 30 m and more. Often gray reef sharks, beautiful tuna fish, mackerels, napoleons, turtles, eagle rays can be seen.

Location: 35 minutes boat ride **Highlights**: Grey reef sharks

Marine life: Sharks, tunas, turtle and lots of small fish **Reef**: 2 Small thila with and few caves overhangs **Diving Depth**: Min. 5 meters – Max. 45 meters


















BERIYAN DHEKUNU * 25**



This long reef opens to the south-eastern side of the atoll. Top reef starts at 5m and slopes down to 30m and features overhangs with strong hard and soft coral growth. Divers can enjoy sharks, rays (seasonal), puffer fish, fusiliers, tunas, moray eels, turtles, and red snappers which are common species on this reef.

Location: 35 minutes boat ride

High lights: nice overhangs with beautiful corals

Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, schools of snappers and fusiliers

Reef: Small thila with overhangs

Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 30 meters





















KINOLHAS DHEKUNU * 26**



Long-drawn beautiful reef open to the ocean on the eastern side of the atoll. Nice soft and hard corals on the overhangs at the corner make this reef so special for divers. Incoming current starts from the outer reef and drifts into the atoll. It brings lots of pelagic fish close to the reef. Barracudas, tunas, glass fish, spine bones, turtles, moray eels, napoleons, rays, blue striped snappers and white tip reef sharks are the most frequent attractions seen here.

Location: 35 minutes boat ride

High lights: nice overhangs with beautiful soft corals

Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, schools of snappers and fusiliers

Reef: Small thila with overhangs.

Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 30 meters




















KOTTEFARU THILA * 27**



Large thila at 8-10 m depth on the top reef and sloping down to 30+m. Beautiful overhangs with lots of gorgonians and soft corals. Sometimes sting rays pass under the overhangs. Manta rays are seasonal on this reef, from June to November where they come to get cleaned on the top reef. All year around you can see oriental sweetlips, large groupers, many red tooth triggerfish, large mackerel swarms, tuna fish and anemones.

Location: 50 minutes boat ride

Highlights: Nice overhangs with beautiful soft corals Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, snappers and fusiliers

Reef: Small thila with overhangs.

Diving Depth: Min. 8 meters – Max. 30 meters **Experience**: For the more experienced diver


















KOTTEFARU *** 28



Long reef with overhangs and strong hard and soft coral growth. Pike-perch, puffer fish, fusilier, pimples, beacon, moray eels, Turtles, perches and snappers are abundant here. At this reef you can find reef sharks, rays, napoleons and it is likely to spot a sleeping leopard shark in the sand.

Location: 50 minutes boat ride

Highlights: Rich fish life with beautiful soft corals.

Marine life: Tuna, trevally, turtle, schools of snappers and fusiliers

Reef: Long reef with overhangs.

Diving Depth: Min. 5 meters – Max. 30 meters




















VIANDHOO WALL * 29**



This reef is with strong coral growth and a reef edge at about 10 m. A steep wall with overhangs and caves from 10 m to 30+m follows. At the impressive steep walls we can see yellow and pink soft corals. The reef is characterized by great napoleons, turtles on the reef roof and on the edge, up to 2 m large giant tuna fish, snappers, fusiliers and frequently also white trip reef sharks. In the summer this is also one of the major manta-points, where we can spend a long time with these impressive animals.

Location: 60 minutes boat ride

Highlights: Soft corals, manta point (seasonal) Marine life: Snappers, sharks, manta and turtles **Reef:** Long-stretched reef with overhangs and caves

Diving Depth: Min. 10 meters – Max. 30 meters **Experience:** For beginners and experienced diver

















DIGHU FARU THILLA * 30**



Medium size thila with built in (plateau?) steps, with strong hard coral growth. From top to bottom on either side the coral growth is very rich. Hard and soft corals with very beautiful overhangs at depths from 10 to 30+m. 
